



PPA Results Framework – Working Draft

GOAL STATEMENT

Promote ethically and economically sound minerals supply chains, due diligence systems, and governance that uphold human rights and labor rights, support environmental responsibility, eliminate links to armed conflict and corruption, and maximize benefits to the communities where minerals are produced. The PPA seeks to have global impact but has particular interest in conflict-affected and high-risk areas, particularly the Great Lakes Region of Central Africa.

PPA OBJECTIVE

The PPA will leverage members’ collective knowledge, influence, networks, and financial resources to inform global responsible minerals sourcing efforts through exploration of key gaps, testing of prospective solutions, convening to promote alignment, and broad amplification of insights and proven models.

OUTCOME 1

Increased alignment of industry operations and governance mechanisms to the OECD Guidance and local governance, to enhance efficiency of due diligence and related governance systems, as well as sustainable development interventions.

OUTCOME 2

Collection and socialization of high-quality independent data to identify key barriers to impactful due diligence, to support measurement of progress, and to inform interventions that maximize benefits for miners and their communities.

OUTCOME 3

Testing and analysis of solutions to key barriers that limit positive local impacts from responsible sourcing efforts or which are obstructing the establishment, effective performance, or governance of due diligence systems.

Alignment gaps are identified and addressed through tools or responses designed in partnership with systems and stakeholders

Sub-outcome 1.2

Improved knowledge and information sharing among systems and stakeholders

Increased engagement with local policymakers and enforcement agencies

Improved access to existing data to bolster due diligence, monitoring, risk mitigation, positive impacts, and reporting

Improved information on the impacts of due diligence and other engagement with mining communities, to improve public and private action

Identification of key upstream barriers to effective due diligence systems and responsible minerals sourcing and sustainability
